The Earth's climate is changing **rapidly**, and the consequences of this change are becoming more evident each year. Scientists agree that human activities, particularly the burning of fossil mels such as coal, oil, and natural gas, are major contributors to this warming. **These** activities release large amounts of greenhouse gases like carbon dioxide (CO2) into the atmosphere. As a result, global temperatures have risen by approximately 1.2°C since the late 19th century, leading to severe impacts on ecosystems, weather patterns, and human societies.

One of the most concerning effects of climate change is the melting of polarice caps and glaciers. As these massive ice formations disappear, sea levels rise, putting coastal cities at risk of flooding. Furthermore, the loss of ice in polar regions threatens species like polar bears, which rely on ice for their hunting and migration. Warmer ocean temperatures also contribute to more frequent and intense storms, such as hurricanes and typhoons.

To combat climate change, governments around the world are working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. For example, the European Union has committed to reducing its emissions by at least 55% by 2030 compared to 1990 levels. Renewable energy sources, like solar and wind power, offer a **sustainable** alternative to fossil fuels. In addition, reforestation projects-aim to absorb CO2 from the atmosphere, helping to slow down global warming.

<u>Technology also plays a key role in addressing climate change.</u> Innovations like carbon capture and storage (CCS) allow companies to trap CO2 emissions before they reach the atmosphere. This technology is still being developed but shows great potential in reducing overall emissions. Scientists are also exploring geoengineering solutions, such as reflecting sunlight away from the Earth to cool the planet.
